## **Appendix H:**

## **Town of Brunswick Resource Targets and Conservation Priority Areas**

Brunswick contains the very western edge (escarpment) of the Rensselaer Plateau, the highest priority ecological area and climate resiliency area in the town. Bald Mountain is visible from more places in the County than probably any other summit and so is a high priority scenic area, as well a high priority ecological and climate resiliency area. There are also extensive high priority scenic areas along and between NYS Routes 2, 278, and 351. High priority agricultural areas are just north of NYS 278, in the northeast portion of the town and in the south-central part of town. The most extensive high priority water resources are Tomhannock Creek and the watershed of the Tomhannock Reservoir. The Poesten Kill, Quacken Kill, Sweet Milk Creek, and Deep Kill also have high priority water resource areas. There are a few small public lands in the town.
