Executive Summary

The following is a series of reports containing the results of botanical inventories of three important natural areas in Rensselaer County: Grafton Lakes State Park (2350 acres, Town of Grafton), Dyken Pond Environmental Education Center (520 acres, towns of Berlin, Grafton, and Poestenkill), and the Rensselaer-Taconic Land Conservancy Butternut Hill Preserve (15.5 acres, Town of Berlin). Plant species discovered in each area are enumerated, and the presence of noteworthy concentrations of plants requiring special management are highlighted. The number of ferns and seed plants was: Grafton Lakes - 629 species, Dyken Pond - 393 species, and Butternut Hill - 157 species. In addition, 70 kinds of bryophytes (mosses and liverworts) also were found to occur in the Butternut Hill Preserve. These figures compare with 1388 species of ferns and seed plants that have been documented from throughout Rensselaer County. The distribution of selected species are shown on maps, as is the vegetation (ecological communities) of Grafton Lakes State Park and the Dyken Pond Center. The reports are available for use in the development of environmental education programs at Grafton Lakes State Park and the Dyken Pond Environmental Education Center.

The inventory data are being maintained in the Rensselaer-Taconic Land Conservancy's (R-TLC's) database. The data can be analyzed in various ways, including specific applications utilizing the R-TLC's Geographic Information System (G.I.S.).

Facts about the contemporary plant life of Rensselaer County are used by the R-TLC as one criterion of several in the evaluation of land that may be targeted for preservation through conservation easements or by other means.

Foreword

Since its founding in 1987, the Rensselaer-Taconic Land Conservancy, Inc. (R-TLC) has worked toward the preservation of the unique landscapes and noteworthy habitats that impart special character to Rensselaer County.

The R-TLC employs several criteria to evaluate the quality of land under consideration for potential protection, including the presence of native plants that are infrequent or possibly in decline. For this reason, the R-TLC began in 1994 to collect information about Rensselaer County's flora. A survey of Rensselaer County plants represented in the Herbarium of the New York State Museum and botanical inventories of some of the county's natural areas were started then, fostered by a grant from the Sweet Water Trust of Boston, Massachusetts, and the efforts of several R-TLC Directors. These data, soon to include some 5200 records stored in the R-TLC's database, are the most detailed collection of information ever assembled about the plant resources of Rensselaer County, but still much more needs to be done.

Additional support received recently by the R-TLC through the interest of Senator Joseph Bruno has carried the project forward significantly. With funds from the New York State Local Assistance Budget, thorough inventories were made of native and naturalized plants growing without cultivation in Grafton Lakes State Park, Rensselaer County's Dyken Pond Environmental Education Center, and Butternut Hill, the last a R-TLC-owned property in Berlin, New York. Grafton Lakes State Park and the Dyken Pond Center, large areas of publicly owned or accessible land (2350 and 502 acres, respectively), were selected for detailed field study. Both also offer successful environmental education programs. An up-to-date census of plants within the park areas and information about where to find examples to show students and others can therefore be put to immediate use in environmental education. In keeping with standards employed in botanical inventories, specimens of all the species recorded by the R-TLC's botanical teams have been deposited at the New York State Museum where the collections will be available for further study.

The reports that follow include detailed maps produced by using the R-TLC's Geographic Information System (G.I.S.), which was employed to help organize and present information gathered on the field surveys. The maps will assist also in educational programming. Moreover, they are useful tools in the management of the botanical resources contained within the park boundaries.

Many volunteers, including R-TLC directors and persons in Rensselaer County with botanical and other needed skills, helped greatly in bringing the reports to completion. A total of 1515 hours was provided by volunteers, a significant tribute to the R-TLC and its work by the Rensselaer County community. The Rensselaer-Taconic Land Conservancy gratefully acknowledges this participation.

With the completion of the three reports, the R-TLC moves closer to being able to evaluate the botanical significance of lands it may consider desirable for preservation. Although the botanical resources of more areas in the county need to be surveyed, the R-TLC is now in a much better position to fulfill its land preservation goals.

Dates of work: May 1 1997 - October 1, 1997. Two days a week were spent collecting, or occasionally a third day. Additional time was spent writing up data for each species, and identifying specimens.

Purpose: to collect all vascular plant species in Grafton Lakes State Park, press and prepare them for mounting; to map locations of all collections and to list each species with appropriate data on location, habitat; and elevation; to describe the plant communities, to prepare about 40 species for Park use; and to make recommendations for park management that would benefit the vegetation.

Methods: First the entire park was explored, to discover what areas looked interesting from a plant point of view. Early spring flowers were looked for particularly in areas that had been noted as being more mesic and richer. As different species came into bloom, they were collected. Return visits were made constantly to areas of interest, particularly wetlands, rich woods, edges, open areas and fields, roadsides, shores and lakes. Four expeditions by boat collected aquatic species. Field notes noted the location and habitat of each species collected, and a site number was assigned for that site. Several species might be collected at that site. Site numbers were then entered on topographical maps in the field. At the end of each day, plants were pressed and assigned a collection number, which was recorded in a notebook. Site numbers were entered on maps kept in the office. Presses were placed on a drier in the consultant's home. Periodically, pressed plants have been submitted to the Rensselaer-Taconic Land Conservancy, along with maps and label data.

Land Use History: (Adapted from information from Warren Broderick) The forests and open areas of the park reflect a long history of human use beginning from the late 18th century. Once part of the Roxborough division of the Manor of Rensselaerwyck, it was settled soon after the American Revolution. Farming and timbering activities stripped most tree cover from the land and the park lands were essentially treeless in the 1890s. Some forest remained around Shaver Pond. Much of farming ended in the mid twentieth century, and since then fields have been reverting to forest.

Long Pond, Shaver Pond and Second Pond have not been altered, with only outlet dams being added. Mill Pond was created for an early grist mill, built in 1802, and known as the Patroon's Mill, being operated for Stephen van Rensselaer. Dunham Reservoir was built as part of Troy's water system in 1905.

The park was opened in 1971. The houses originally on land acquired for the park were torn down, and these areas are gradually returning to brush and forest. Given the land use history, it is not surprising that most of the forests are very young. Along Shaver Pond Road, the forests are barely beyond the brushy stage. On Long Pond Road, open areas denote old camp sites. Because of long cultivation and habitation, garden plants persist at the edges of roads and clearings. More mature forests such as on Dunham hill and on slopes north of Long Pond may occupy areas abandoned first, as not easily cultivated. Present activities, such as mowing, keep some areas open and provide habitat for grasses and meadow species. Beaver, returning in the thirties, create marshes, swamps, small ponds, open margins around ponds, and eventually meadows. Red spruce can be a major pioneer species in cool moist higher elevation climates, and it is found in almost every plant community. Wetlands may have increased since farming ceased, but many of the hemlock-hardwood swamps probably never were drained, and probably were left alone as useless. The plant communities of the park, now protected, are still evolving from the cleared state to something more representative of their original state.

Ecological Communities: Designations of the communities follows *Ecological Communities of New York State* by Carol Reschke and are arranged in the same order. Mileage and acreage are taken from the digitized map created by Warren Broderick and Reginald Soracco, based on communities designated by P. Weatherbee and K. Deitz, and other maps.

III. RIVERINE SYSTEMS

A. Natural Streams (4.12 miles)

1. Rocky headwater stream (1.21 mi.): The Quacken Kill, and a stream from Shaver Pond
2. Marsh headwater stream (2.34 mi.): portions of Shaver Pond Brook, stream through marsh at north end of Shaver Pond, portions of Grist Mill Brook
6. Intermittent stream (.57 mi.): several throughout park

IV. LACUSTRINE (322.89 acres)

A. Natural Lakes and Ponds (202.59 acres)

5. Oligotrophic pond (4.12 acres) Shaver Pond has *Lobelia dortmanna*, *Nymphoides cordata*, *Potamogeton spirillus* and *P. amplifolius*.
15. Oligotrophic dimictic lake (198.47 acres) Long Lake has *Elodea canadensis*, *E. nuttallii*, *Potamogeton amplifolius*, and a strong growth of *Myriophyllum spicatum* which may become a pest.

B. Lacustrine cultural (120.3 acres)

4. Reservoir/impoundment-Mill and Second Ponds: both ponds have *Myriophyllum spicatum*, *Potamogeton amplifolius*, *Elodea canadensis*, *Elatine minima*, and *Vallisneria americana*. Dunham Reservoir has abundant *Isoetes echinospora* and *I. engelmannii*, also much *Proserpinaca palustris* var. *crebra*, *Utricularia macrorhiza*, *U. gibba* and *Potamogeton bicupulatus*, indicating fairly acidic water.

V. PALUSTRINE SYSTEM (103.91 ACRES)

A. Open mineral soil wetlands (60.85 acres)

1. Deep emergent marsh (17.12 acres): best example is the marsh south of Route 2 at base of field, where *Typha latifolia* is dominant, *Sparganium* spp., *Calamagrostis canadensis*, *Iris versicolor*, *Scirpus cyperinus* are common. Some open water hosts *Nuphar variegata*.
2. Shallow emergent marsh (36.45 acres): several examples in park; the marsh beyond the north end of Shaver Pond is dominated by *Calamagrostis canadensis*; *Glyceria canadensis*, and other graminoids are common. The abandoned beaver swamp along Shaver Pond brook is bordered by this community.
3. Shrub swamp (7.28 acres) dominated by *Spiraea latifolia*, *Salix* spp. *Alnus incana* ssp. *rugosa*. A good example is the shrub swamp at the base of the field, east of Gartlers Trail.
6. Inland non-calcareous shore- common along the ponds. *Dulichium arundinaceum*, *Glyceria borealis*, *Polygonum* spp., *Juncus effusus*, *Equisetum fluviatile* are commonly seen.

B. Open peatlands (2.77 acres)

5. Rich sloping fen- a narrow strip of moist meadow stretching from Rte 2 down to the shrub swamp. *Geum rivale*, *Senecio aureus*, *Cicuta maculata*, *Carex conoidea*, *Scirpus microcarpus* indicate a more circumneutral soil. *Platanthera psycodes* was found here and in the adjacent shrub swamp and deep emergent swamp. Not really rich, and lacking many of the indicator sedges, little peat seen.

C. Forested mineral soil wetlands (40.29 acres)

2. Red maple-hardwood swamp (18.64 acres): the largest example is south of the blueberry plantation. Here *Acer rubrum*, *Betula alleghaniensis*, a few *Fraxinus nigra* and *Picea rubens* form an open canopy, *Spiraea alba* var. *latifolia*, *Ilex verticillata*, *Alnus incana* ssp. *rugosa* and *Vaccinium corymbosum* are in the shrub layer, and *Osmunda cinnamomea*, *O. regalis*, *Dryopteris cristata*, *Bidens* spp., *Arisaema triphyllum* ssp. *stewardsonii*, *Calla palustris* and *Myosotis laxa* are among the many herbaceous species here. The topography is of pools and hummocks covered with sphagnum. Another good site is opposite the "brown garage" off Long Pond Rd. just north of the Spruce Bog Trail, where *Lindera benzoin* was found.
4. Vernal pool (.76 acres): a small probably originally man-made pool (amphibian eggs were found) near the beginning of Gartlers Trail off Dunham Rd., and two pools east of the summit ridge of Hill S of Dunham Reservoir (no eggs seen).
6. Hemlock-hardwood swamp (20.89 acres): a common type in the park. There is always *Picea rubens* along with *Acer rubrum*, *Betula alleghaniensis*, *Osmunda cinnamomea*, *Carex trisperma*, hummocks of sphagnums. A good example is a swamp in a depression, off the RPI trail from Shaver Pond Rd. Here *Calla palustris*, *Caltha palustris*, *Saxifraga pensylvanica*, *Corallorrhiza trifida* and *Malaxis unifolia* make this an interesting site.

VI. Terrestrial Systems (1,924.53 acres)

A. Open uplands (33.52 acres)

11. Shoreline outcrop: occasionally along the shores of the lakes open rocky exposed areas occur. *Gaylussacia baccata*, *Vaccinium corymbosum*, *Nemopanthus mucronata* are common shrubs. Herbaceous species include *Hypericum* spp., *Juncus* spp. and *Platanthera clavellata* was noted taking advantage of the open site along the shore of Shaver Pond.

16. Cliff community (.74 acres) *Polypodium virginianum* is one of few plant species here. Talus below cliff has *Ribes glandulosum*, *Acer spicatum*. This community is best seen at the summit of the hill south of Dunham Reservoir. Turkey vulture nest with young was observed here.
21. Successional blueberry heath (18.9 acres): the large blueberry plantation east of Gartlers Trail. Here open fields were planted with highbush blueberries. The paths between the shrubs are mowed occasionally but *Populus tremuloides*, *Crataegus* spp., and *Acer rubrum* are beginning to take over.
22. Successional old field (2.84 acres): several small patches, some around old house sites; most are succeeding into successional shrublands.
23. Successional shrublands (11.04 acres): good examples are the area between the main access road and Shaver Pond Rd. near Rte 2, and the fishermens access on Shaver Pond Rd. *Cornus racemosa*, *Spiraea alba* var. *latifolia*, *Crataegus* spp., are common shrubs; *Anthoxanthum odoratum*, other grasses, *Solidago* spp., and weedy species are seen here.

C. Forested uplands (1,748.45 acres)

4. Pitch pine-oak forest (1.49 acres): a very small area on a knoll northeast of the large earth dam on Dunham Reservoir. Here *Pinus rigida*, *Quercus alba*, *Quercus coccinea* have an understory of *Shizachyrium scoparium* and *Vaccinium angustifolium*. There are several specimens of the scarlet oak, and numerous saplings and seedlings of the pitch pine.
11. Beech-maple mesic forest (455.56 acres): This forest is best developed on the north-facing slope of the hill south of Dunham Reservoir, and the slopes around the northeast end of Long Pond. At Long Pond there are fewer rich woods indicator species, but *Asarum canadense*, *Cardamine diphylla*, *Botrychium virginianum* were observed here. On the Dunham slope, a very nice spring flora is evident: *Caulophyllum thalictroides*, *Actaea pachypoda*, *Claytonia caroliniana*, *Dicentra cucullaria*, *Deparia acrostichoides*, *Adiantum pedatum*, *Geranium robertianum*, *Schizachne purpurascens*, *Viola canadensis*, *Carex pedunculata*, *Laportea canadensis* indicate a circumneutral mesic site. *Acer saccharum* is dominant; there is less *Fagus grandifolia* and a few *Tilia americana*.
13. Hemlock-northern hardwood forest (663.74 acres): the most common forest community in the park. There are large patches along Shaver Pond and Long Pond, interspersed with successional northern hardwoods and grading into spruce hardwoods. *Tsuga* may be dominant and dense, or occur with *Acer rubrum*, *Quercus rubra*, *Prunus serotina*, *Pinus strobus*, *Fagus grandifolia*. Herb layer is sparse, consisting of *Lycopodium*, *Maianthemum canadense*, *Dryopteris intermedia*, *Dennstaedtia punctilobula*, *Uvularia sessilifolia*, *Trientalis borealis*, *Viola rotundifolia*.
15. Spruce flats (7.33 acres): a dense forest of mainly *Picea rubens* on level poorly drained soil, occurring along the lower portion of the Gartlers Trail, as it parallels Quacken Kill.
17. Spruce-northern hardwoods (223.12 acres): best seen along the lower Gartlers Trail, and along the red maple-hardwood swamp there; also along the northern part of the Spruce Bog Trail, and Chet Bell Trail. Here *Picea rubens* occurs with *Acer saccharum*, *Acer rubrum*, *Betula papyrifera*, *Fagus grandifolia*. *Viburnum lantanoides*, *Acer pensylvanicum* are shrub and under story species. Herbaceous species include *Dryopteris intermedia*, *Oxalis acetosella*, *Aralia nudicaulis*, mosses and lycopodium.
20. Successional northern hardwoods (396.41 acres): a common community, occurring where fields were abandoned. The many stone walls and stone heaps indicate clearing and cultivation.

There are large areas along Shaver Pond Rd, Long Pond Rd. and a large area west of Johnson/Horton rd. as it descends to Dunham Reservoir. *Acer rubrum* is dominant, the trees are young and crowded. *Populus tremuloides*, *P. grandidentata*, *Prunus serotina* are common. *Amelanchier arborea*, *A. laevis*, *Viburnum dentatum* var. *lucidum* are common understory species. Ferns and lycopodiums are abundant ground cover.

D. Terrestrial cultural (142.56 acres)

3. Pastureland (1.71 acres): a fenced area behind the maintenance building used for horse pasture.
8. Pine plantation (15.34 acres): large patches of *Pinus resinosa* are planted in rows along the southern end of the RPI Trail, and in small patches between main access rd and Shaver Pond Rd. Little grows under the trees except the very occasional *Goodyera tesselata*.
9. Spruce-fir plantation (24.79 acres): several large planted patches of *Picea abies* occur along the edge of Dunham Reservoir and up on the slope.
10. Conifer plantation (.5 acres): a small plantation of *Larix kaempferi* occurs among the *Pinus resinosa* to the south of Hicks Trail. Several trees of this species occur also in an old field near the office area.
11. Mowed lawn with trees (11.85 acres)
12. Mowed lawn (15.33 acres) There are numerous areas along the roads and recreation areas that are mowed regularly. The large field south of Rte 2 is mowed at least annually. It is dominated by grasses.
13. Mowed roadside/pathway (26.67 acres): a common community which has species needing light, and also weedy species. Vegetation under power lines is either mowed or cut.
15. Unpaved road/path (26.1 acres) common throughout park
16. Paved road/path (15.32 acres) The parking lots and the many cracks and crevices host many weedy species such as *Sagina procumbens*, *Agrostis pectinacea*, *Arenaria serpyllifolia*, *Panicum dichotomoflorum*.
23. Artificial beach (3.33 acres): at south end of Long Pond.
29. Landfill/dump (.44 acres): mostly soil, stumps and brush, off road to water tank, near Long Pd.
33. Rural structure exterior (1.18 acres):

Under-collected or under-explored areas

Both the red maple-hardwood and hemlock-hardwood swamps could always be explored again. The area on either side of the Spruce Bog Trail was not completely explored. More aquatic work could be done. The beech-maple area north of Long Pond could be looked at again. Three species that were not collected, but were noted, are: *Pontederia cordata*, seen in the north end of Shaver Pond, but completely grazed, *Aplos americana*, possibly noted along the west shore of Shaver Pond between the fisherman's access and the Nature Trail, but not returned to and collected, and *Pogonia ophioglossoides*, which was seen by Bill Town at *Sarracenia purpurea* site. These could be looked for next season.

In addition, all native clubmosses, all ferns except *Pteridium aquilinum* var. *latiusculum*, *Dennstaedtia punctilobula* and *Onoclea sensibilis* and all native orchids are included under the "exploitably vulnerable" designation.

Recommendations:

The major recommendation we would like to suggest concerns a strip of field at the base of the large field east of Rte 2 and running along the deep emergent (cattail) marsh and shrub swamp. We would recommend that a strip of field 20-25 feet wide adjacent to the marsh not be mowed until late fall. If it is necessary to mow parts of the field early for the geese, mowing could take place outside this strip. The reason for this is that early in the season large orchid leaves were seen in this moist to wet section of land. However, they were mowed and never matured. We believe that these were leaves of *Platanthera psycodes* which was seen later flowering in the shrub swamp and wet meadow. In September the small orchid *Spiranthes cernua* was found at the edge of the marsh. It is our thinking that an expanded grassy border along this wetland would provide additional habitat for these two handsome orchids.

Also it might be interesting to delay similarly mowing on the "rich sloping fen" area, so that species such as *Geum rivale* could mature. It might also lead to higher diversity in this moist meadow. This could be marked. It is generally an area or strip about 200 feet wide downhill to the shrub swamp from an outlet under the road.

We don't know what the policy is in the park, but we think a viable population of beavers somewhere should be allowed to continue their valuable habitat creation role.


There are relatively few invasive alien species in the park, and those that are there are not yet widespread or a pest. *Myriophyllum spicatum* Eurasian milfoil is quite thick in Long Pond and present in Mill and Second Ponds. It may begin to cause problems with boating. There are two weevils being used in Vermont to control Eurasian milfoil. The one plant of *Lythrum salicaria* we removed, and if it appears again, it should be immediately removed. *Phragmites australis* appears in two places, the marsh North of Hicks Trail bridge, and near Dunham Reservoir. These should be watched. It is almost impossible to eradicate. *Celastrus orbiculata* Oriental bittersweet occurs in one place along Long Pond Rd. This can be a terrible pest. Acidic soil may slow its progress, but it can take over whole roadsides. This should be watched for expansion. *Polygonum cuspidatum*, which occurs under the powerline near Long Pond Rd., can also be very invasive. An effort should be made to limit or eliminate these last two species.

Summary

Grafton Lakes State Park has a variety of habitats and plant communities. Much of the land has been cleared, cultivated, pastured and inhabited before being acquired by the park, so that many plants associated with human occupation are seen. Much of the forest is young, successional, and will be changing over the years. The wetland communities should persist and not change appreciably. Although the generally acidic soil and cool climate do not produce a very diverse flora, it has some beautiful swamps and marshes, and some mature forests. It is generally a northern ecosystem.



Explanation of Accompanying Maps

Ecological Community Maps. As discussed above, thirty-one ecological communities were identified and mapped, corresponding with the Reschke system. The first set of these two maps shows the ecological subsystems found in the study area. In all these maps, natural streams and trails are depicted as linear communities, while all other communities are treated as mutually-exclusive polygons.

Another set of two maps depicts only the six forested upland communities found in the study area. Four types of forested uplands occur in significantly large areas, namely the hemlock-northern hardwood forest, beech-maple mesic forest, successional northern hardwoods and the spruce-northern hardwood forest. These maps also reveal the occurrence of a small area of pitch pine-oak forest, unusual for the Rensselaer Plateau. The maps of wetlands show the diversity of the study area, containing seven different wetland communities. The most unusual of these is the rich sloping fen found south of Route 2. The map of 11 cultural communities shows only an enlargement of the part of the study area where many of these communities are located. The precise mapping of small communities, is evident from this map.

Plant Collection Maps. Two maps show plant collections in the study area. The first two show the location of all 763 collections completed as part of this project, north and south of Route 2 respectively.

Plant Distribution Maps. A plant distribution study was conducted covering 57 specific plants. One set of two maps shows the locations of all 57 plants which were studied. For each of these plants, locations of site observations were mapped as well as the locations of actual collections. Some of these show locations of plants found at only one location each, while others show plant distribution at various locations over the entire study area. Maps covering 25 of the individual plants studied are included in this version of the Report. Plants common throughout the study area were not mapped.


In addition, three maps were prepared which further analyze this plant distribution data. One map shows the locations of all native members of the orchid family (*Orchidaceae*) found in the study area. Another shows the distribution of the two members of the genus *Trillium* found growing naturally at the State Park. The final map shows 5 representative herbaceous plants found in the single rich sloping fen community found in the study area.







Grafton Lakes State Park Plant Distribution




